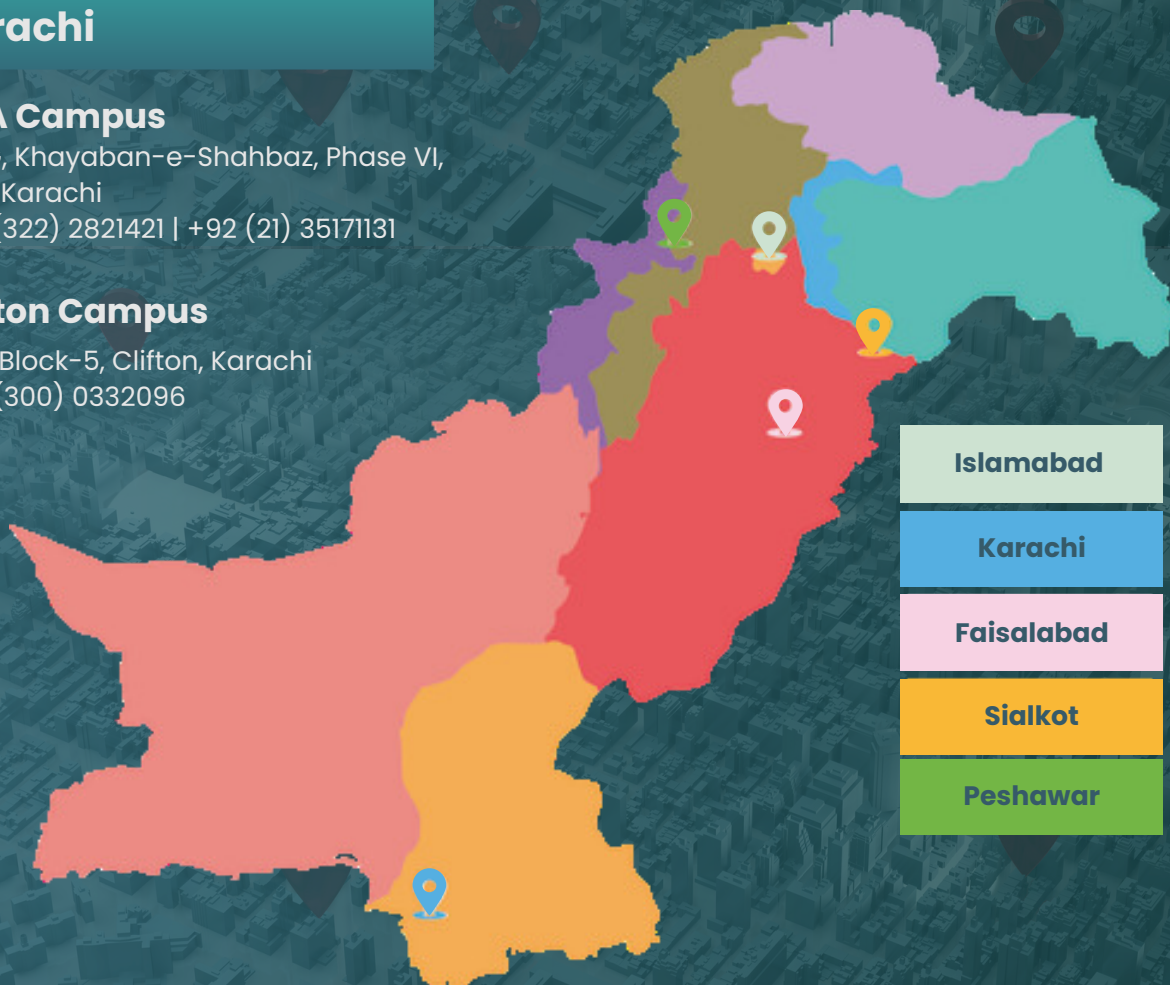

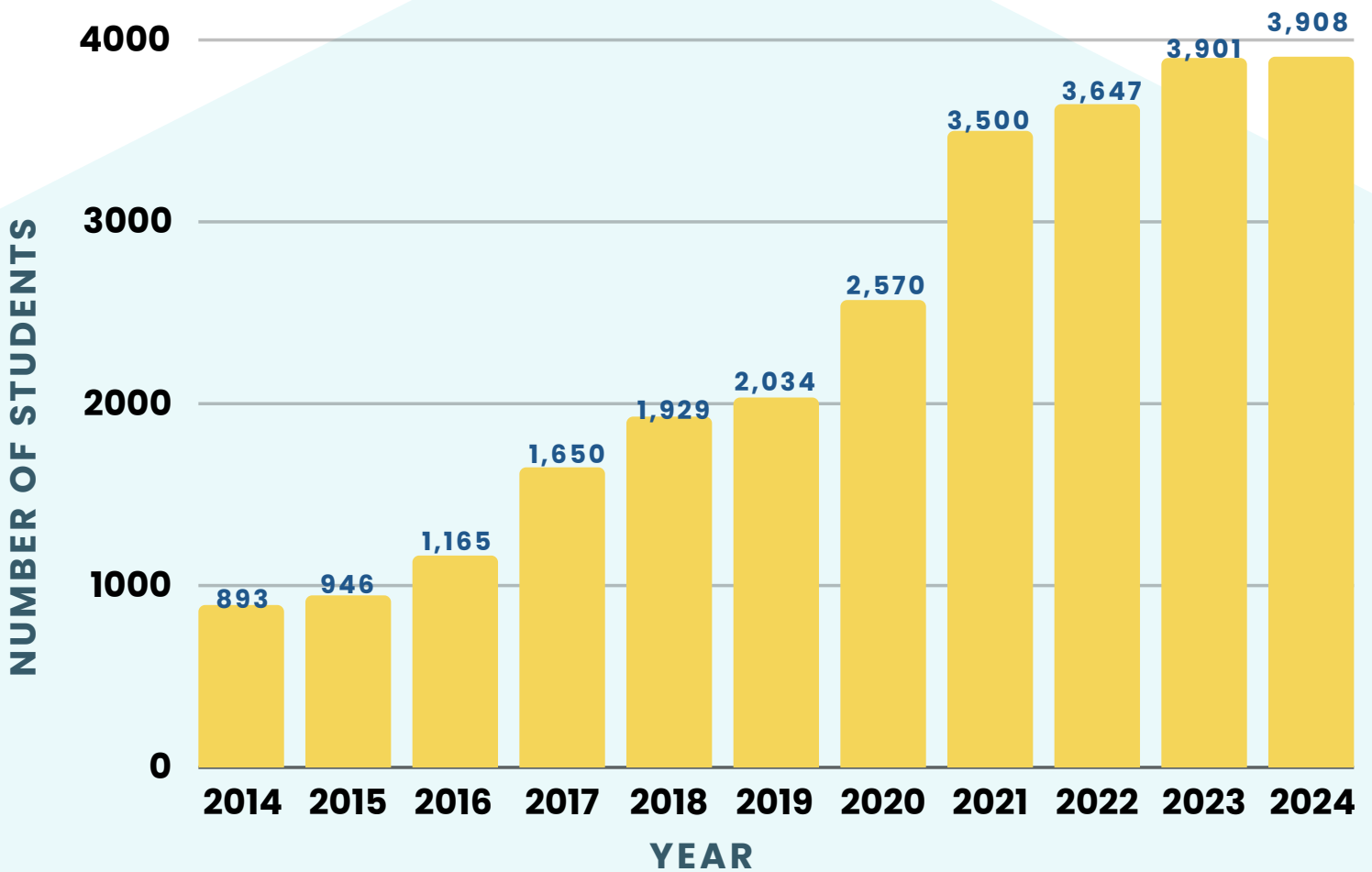

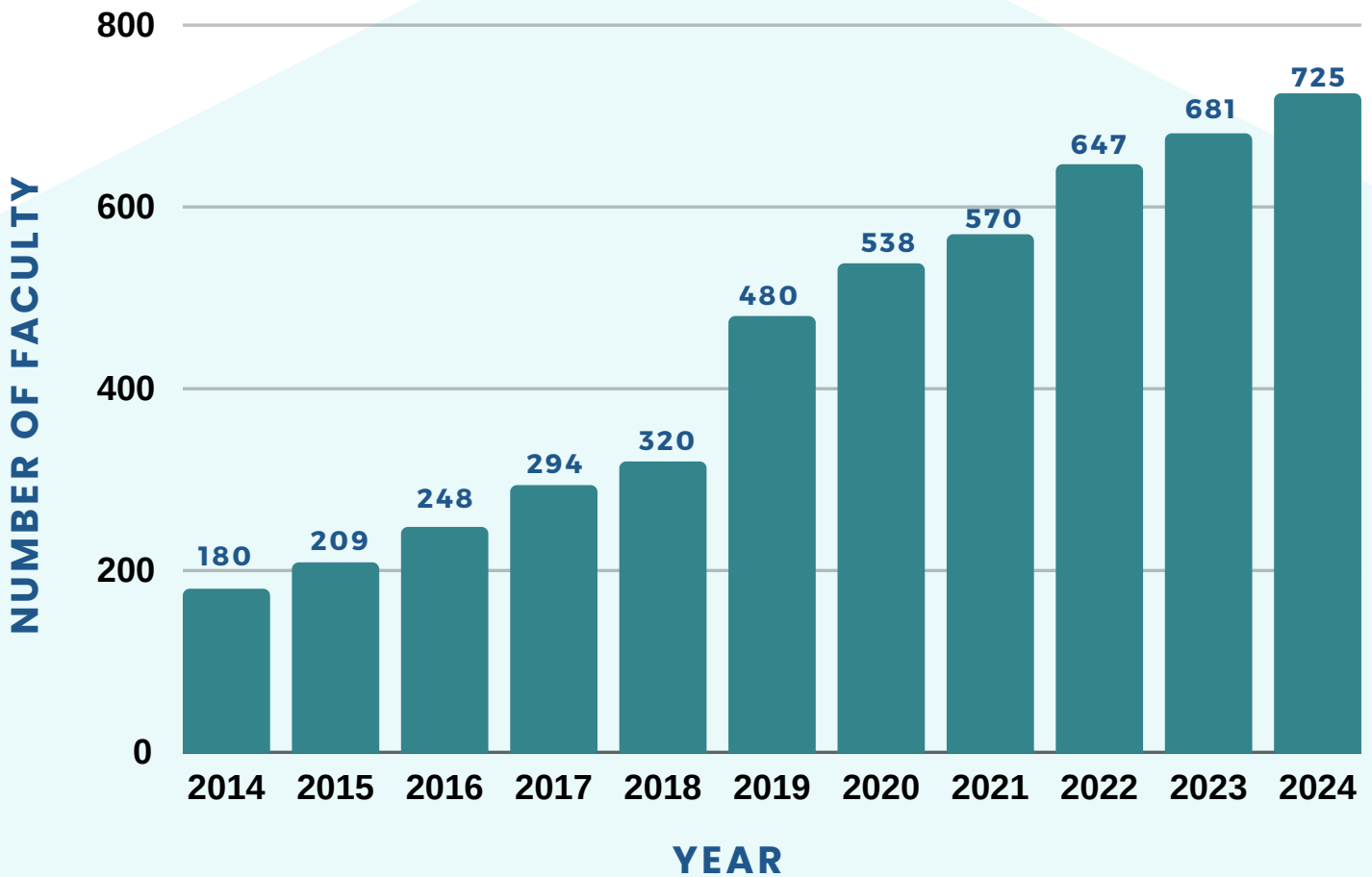

ADMISSIONS STATISTICS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR

The institution received a total of 3113 applications for the last academic year. Despite overwhelming interest, admissions were granted to 640 new students, including 48 dedicated to Hifz. Due to capacity constraints, the institution was unable to accommodate more qualified applicants.

AIS Website PERFORMANCE OVERVIEW

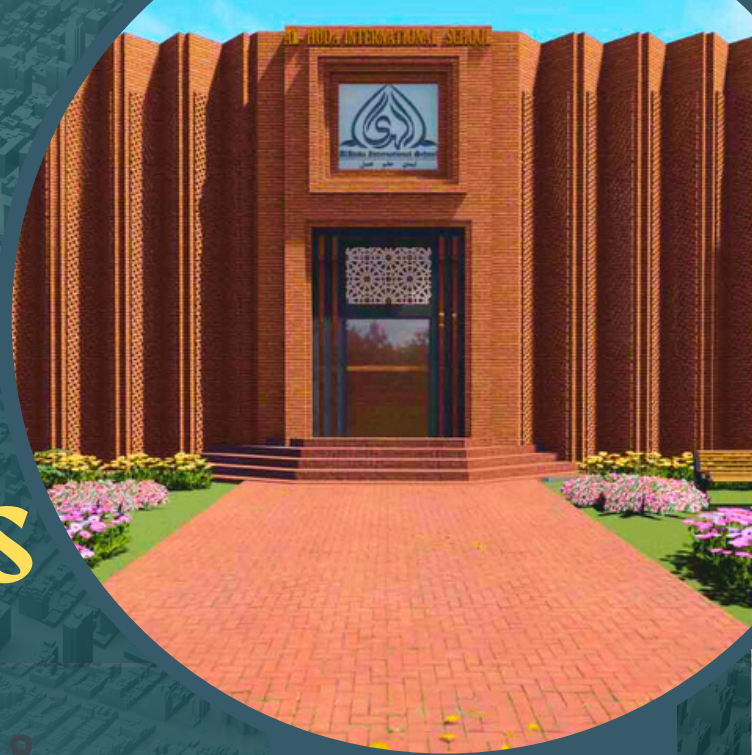
The **Website Insights** from **1st July 2023 to 30th June 2024** indicate substantial growth, with active users increasing by over 370% compared to the previous period.

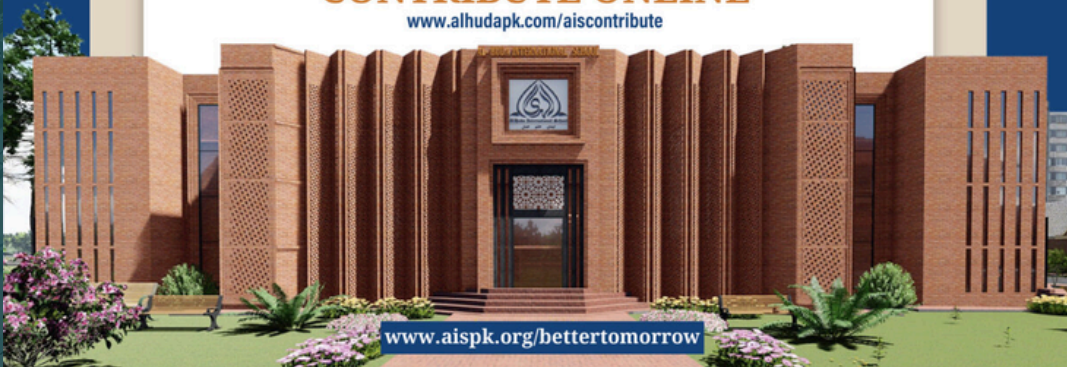
